PRIMARY FRUIT BREAK

Primary students are able to have a fruit break mid morning commencing next Monday, 28 March. This fresh fruit break will give students natural sugar energy which will help them stay on task during class. THREE WAY PARENT TEACHER STUDENT INTERVIEWS

Parents and their secondary children are invited to attend the Three Way Interviews on Monday, 28 March from 3:30-7:30PM. Teachers are keen to see the students, along with their parents/guardians, as this is the most effective way to transmit information. No appointments are necessary. You just need to come to the hall and visit with the teacher/s that you would like to. Please keep appointments to 5-10 minutes as most teachers will be in high demand. If you require a longer appointment, please bring your diary along with you and make a time with the teacher on the night. Please note, that due to the length of the session, the teachers will be taking a short meal break at various times throughout the evening.

LICE

Thursday night is headlice checking night. Please continue to check your child's hair to ensure they do not have head lice. If live headlice are found in your child's hair you will be rung to collect your child immediately, as these lice are very friendly and will attach themselves to other students in the school. A headlice check is conducted weekly at school.

PIZZA LUNCH

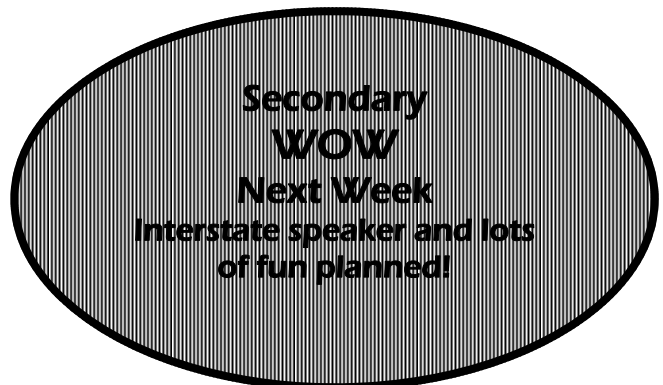
