ENROLMENTS FOR 2012

We are receiving many enquiries and applications for KAS next year, both in PreKindy and Kindergarten to Year 12. PRIMARY REPORTS AND PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEWS

Primary reports will be available for collection from the school office on Wednesday, 20 July, from 8:30AM to 3:30PM. Reports not collected will be posted home that evening.

All families with children in the primary school are expected to attend an interview with your child's teacher at a time of your choosing.
