ANNOUNCEMENTS

CYBERSAFETY

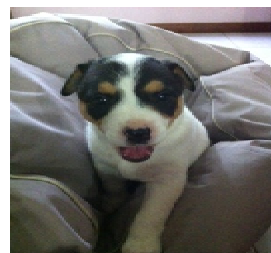


YR 11 CAMP 25-30 March
