SCABIES

There have been some isolated reports of scabies in the primary school. Please read the signs below and seek treatment through your chemist if you suspect your child might have this complaint.

- The main symptoms are pimple-like irritations, burrows or rash of the skin, especially the webbing between the fingers; the skin folds on the wrist, elbow, or knee; the penis, the breast, or shoulder blades.
- intense itching, especially at night and over most of the body.
- sores on the body caused by scratching. These sores can sometimes become infected by bacteria.
