## ALL SCHOOL ANNOUNCEMENTS

### FAMILY PORTRAITS

### SCHOOL PHOTOS

Our school photos will be taken on **Monday 30 July**. Every child is expected to be in perfect school uniform, including polished school shoes. If your child normally wears a sport uniform on this day, please ensure they were their academic uniform for the photos. They can bring their sport uniform in their bag and get changed into it later if they wish.

A standard photo pack is covered for students in Kindy to Yr 12 in your school fees. If you wish to order extra copies for family and friends envelopes can be collected from the school office. You can also order group or sibling photos. These envelopes are also found at the front office. It is important to note that these additional photos are an extra cost which is paid by the family. Money for these photos is to be placed in the order form envelope. **No photos of groups/siblings will be taken without the form and accompanying money.** If you wish to have extra photos please see the ladies in the front office for the envelopes.
