YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

KEMPSEY NAIDOC AWARDS

There are several categories in the local Kempsey NAIDOC Awards. Applications can be collected from our school office. The categories are as follows:

- High School/Primary School Student of the Year- Must be between 8-18yrs old
- Youth for the Year 2011/12- Age 12-24
- Sporting Team 2011/12- Senior/ 18 and above, Junior/18 and under

- Sporting Person 2011/12- Senior/ 18 and above, Junior 18 and under
- Volunteer Person 2011/12- Open age group
- Naidoc Person of the Year 2011/12- Open age group

All applications require written information of at least three paragraphs relating to the criteria outline above. Completed application forms with the written information should be dropped into the Nomination box in the AES Office in Belgrave Street, Kempsey. Nominations must be made by 25th June 2012.

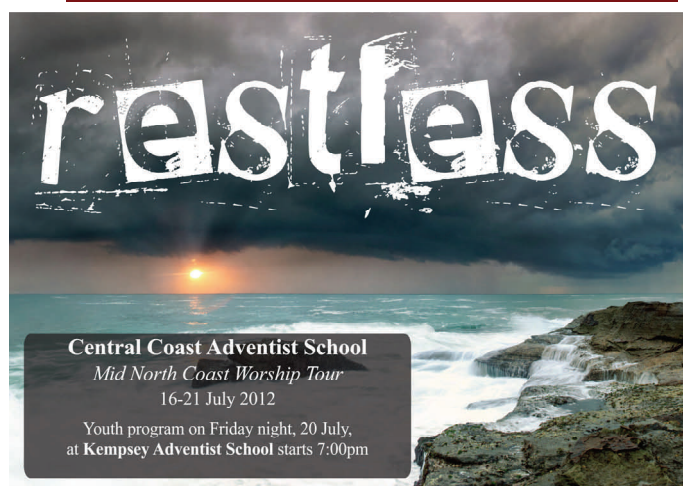

SCHOLARSHIPS

KAS offers several scholarships each year to students commencing both Year 7 and Year 11 or 12.

Year 7 Scholarships—these scholarships are available for **new** students to KAS who may be joining us from another school. (Current KAS students entering Yr 7 are able to receive a scholarship if they receive the General Excellence Scholarship at Presentation Night at the end of the year).

There are 3 scholarship categories available - Leadership, Academic and Citizenship. These scholarships provide for 50% of tuition fees for the school year, however, they may be extended on a yearly basis.

Yr 11 or 12 Scholarships— these scholarships are available for **any** student enrolling in Year 11 or 12 at KAS in 2013. They provide a fully-funded place for the student in either of these years and maybe extended subject to a twice yearly review.
