ALL SCHOOL ANNOUNCEMENTS

FREE BUS TRAVEL APPLICATIONS

If you have applied for free bus travel and have not received a pass, please ask at the KAS office or the bus driver. Once a student has submitted a free bus travel application to the KAS office, all they need is a copy of that application and they are permitted to catch the bus. Sometimes the bus driver has the pass and is waiting for the student to get onto the bus to give it to them.

PRIVATE VEHICLE SUBSIDY

The Private Vehicle Conveyance (PVC) Subsidy is available to eligible school students where there is no public transport available for all or part of the journey. The PVC Subsidy is paid based on the distance between their home and the nearest transport pick up point or school. The PVC Subsidy may also be available on medical grounds. The KAS office has application forms.

LOST BUS PASS

If your child has lost their bus pass, they can ask the driver for a 'Lost Bus Pass Form'. The form will need to be completed by the parent and returned to the driver with a payment of \$10 to \$15 depending on the bus company.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

If families change address or change school, it is important to complete a new bus application at the KAS office.

TROUBLE ON BUSES

If your child experiences trouble on the school bus, it is advisable to report it directly to the bus company. Busways – 65 624 724. Cavanaghs – 65 627 800.
