Car Parking Guidelines

Rationale

The parking of cars and other vehicles in and around the school grounds is a daily necessity, but also raises a number of safety and traffic issues that must be well managed.

Aims

To ensure that staff, school community, visitor and student car and vehicle parking in and around the school grounds is orderly, safe and in accordance with the law.

Implementation

- The parking of any vehicle inside the school grounds is at the discretion of the principal.
- The staff car park is for use by staff members only, and will be clearly signposted as such.
- Parents/guardians or visitors who park in the staff car park will be reminded of the need to park elsewhere. Habitual offenders may be referred to the local council for prosecution.
- The visitor's car park will not be used by staff.
- Staff members will not approach members of the community who are parking inappropriately inside the school grounds.
- No person is to drive a vehicle onto the school grounds without prior approval from the principal.
- Sufficient disabled car parking will be available and monitored.
- The school will provide a staggered finish to the school day to encourage students leaving the school by bus to depart prior to parents to collect students in their private vehicles.
- Proper and safe parking practices will be regular features of the school newsletter.
- Senior students may choose to drive their own vehicle to school subject to complying with the expectations of the KAS Senior Student Private Vehicle Transport Guidelines

Evaluation

These guidelines will be reviewed as part of a three-year school review cycle.
