# 2024 HSC Scholarship **Application Guidelines**

Kempsey Adventist School (KAS) believes in the development of the individual student in all facets of human endeavour; academically, spiritually, emotionally, physically and socially. KAS believes that these characteristics are best developed in a Christ-centred, serving and caring environment. We wish to encourage students in developing these essential characteristics and, attract students to our school that will strengthen and support our school culture.

The KAS HSC Scholarships may be awarded to a student who is enrolling into either Year 11 or Year 12 at KAS in 2024.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## 1. Under what criteria are the KAS HSC Scholarships awarded?

The scholarships may be awarded to a student who completes all elements of the application process and is able to demonstrate consistent application to academic performance, behavioural expectations, school community life, respect for our Christian ethos and appropriate role modelling to others. Students will be assessed on information provided in all sections of the application form, including references, academic records and response to questions.

#### 2. Are there any conditions attached to the scholarships?

Yes. Scholarships are subject to a student maintaining a commitment in a number of areas. These include academic achievement, participation in school community events as well as respect for the Christian ethos of the school. Further to this, it is expected that they will be an appropriate example and role model to junior students and will display an attitude and behaviour which meets the expectations of the KAS Student Management Policy and Student Code of Conduct. This is subject to a twice yearly review process. This is a one year scholarship which can be reapplied for in 2024 for students entering in Year 12 2025.

### 3. How much do these Scholarships cover?

KAS HSC Scholarships provide for full funding of the applicable year level school fees at KAS in 2024. That is, successful students will hold a fully funded position at the school for the year of application whilst they meet the ongoing expectations of the KAS HSC Scholarship program.

Successful applicants will be subject to a twice-yearly review process. Their continuation of the scholarship will be subject to the student maintaining a commitment to academic achievement, participation in school community events, respect for the Christian ethos of the school, provisions of an appropriate example and



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role model to junior students and a display of attitudes and behaviour which meets the expectations of the KAS Student Management Policy and Student Code of Conduct.

# 4. What will happen if a student fails to meet the expectations of the HSC Scholarship program?

If during the course of regular school events and/or in the course of the twice-yearly review process, a student is identified as failing to meet the expectations of the HSC Scholarship program, parents/guardians and the individual student will be notified in writing of the school's concerns.

In such an event, the School Executive may determine to either cancel the scholarship or alternatively impose a period of probation with or without attached conditions, to determine the given students' suitability to continue as a scholarship holder. Any such decision by the School Executive to either cancel, impose a period of probation, with or without conditions, will be considered as final.

In the event that a scholarship is cancelled, parents/guardians will then become responsible for the payment of applicable school fees less the portion of the year and or years covered by the applicable scholarship.

### 5. How do we apply?

- Read the Scholarship Guidelines carefully.
- Complete the application form.
- Attach all relevant documents.
- Send the completed form and attachments to by Friday, 20 October 3:30 PM.

#### 6. Does the scholarship cover other tuition?

Please note that these scholarships are purely financial. They do not entitle the student to any extra tutoring or differing academic program. However, due to the dedicated staff, structured classes and our Student Support Program, parents can be guaranteed of appropriate academic support for their student.

### 7. Is there a cut-off date for application?

Yes. These scholarships are for study in 2024. Hence, it is necessary to act promptly if you wish to be considered for a scholarship. Applications close on Friday, 20 October 2023.

#### 8. When will we be notified of the result of our application?

Notice will be given by mail or phone as to whether your application has been successful or unsuccessful.

Please note that there is no guarantee that your application will be successful. Each application is assessed on an individual basis, and students are accepted at the discretion of the KAS School Executive.

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
